Bldgs 8-9-10

As a reminder the annunciators (Horns) installed in your unit are NOT smoke detectors and as long as we are a monitored system can ONLY be silenced at the Fire Alarm Panel by Fire Department Personnel.

The personal smoke detectors you have in your unit (whether they are battery operated or wired into your unit's electrical panel) are not tied into the building's fire alarm system.

If you set off your personal smoke detector it will only sound in your unit and will not activate the Fire Alarm System.

The procedures for activating the Fire Alarm System in buildings 8, 9, or 10 are as follows:

If there is a fire in your building or unit, as you evacuate, you need to set off the Fire Alarm System by activating one of the fire alarm pull-stations located outside each stairwell entrance on either end of the buildings five floors.

This is done by lifting the clear weatherproof cover and pulling the pull-station handle. The alarms (annunciators) will then sound inside the units and on the exterior of the building and the strobes on the exterior of the building will flash.

The Fire Alarm Systems in buildings 8, 9, and 10 are a Monitored Fire Alarm System and if the system is operating properly the Fire Department will be notified automatically after the alarm has been activated.

It is also a smart system and will know if an annunciator (Horn) in your unit has been disabled.

Our fire alarm monitoring company will be notified automatically via a phone line dialer hooked up to the system.
